

“In From the Cold: A Peaceful Reunion”

**A week of activities featuring former crewmembers of K-77,
Cold Warriors who served on Rhode Island’s Russian submarine
May 4-12, 2004**

For seven days in May, cold war adversaries who once hunted each other above and beneath the sea will meet in Rhode Island for a peaceful and educational purpose.

Tuesday, May 4

- K-77 delegation visits Russian sub, meets Saratoga volunteers and staff. School visitation program begins: Cranston West and Cranston East High Schools. Members of the Russian delegation will provide a once-in-a-lifetime perspective for Rhode Island students about the other side of the Cold War.

Wednesday, May 5

- Visits to Pilgrim and Tollgate High Schools (Warwick); Davisville Middle School (North Kingstown)

Thursday, May 6

- School visits continue; Community Prep (Providence); St. Rocco's (Johnston). Informal Soviet/US naval veteran dialogue at Russian Sub Museum, 5 - 6PM

Friday, May 7

- All day “Cold War at Sea” conference at the Naval War College (invitation only)
- Reception at the Newport Naval Station Officers Club

Saturday, May 8

- Day 2 of the Naval War College conference (invitation only)
- Private dinner hosted by Professor Sergei Khrushchev (invitation/benefactors only)

Sunday, May 9

- Victory Day Open House at the Russian Sub Museum with Russian veterans and Rhode Island’s Russian community. The activities culminate in a late afternoon reception to toast with our Russian guests as they commemorate the defeat of Nazi Germany in 1945.
- VIP reception aboard the submarine (maximum 50 people) and private tour of the missile control room and other areas normally closed to the public.

Monday May 10

- International Conference sessions at Watson Institute, Brown University; open to the public, including serious academic presentations as well as discussion about sub development and operations among Russian veterans and their American counterparts
- Special luncheon presentation (ticketed event) by Francis Gary Powers, Jr.
